**Sandy** Have you booked our Memphis tour on Saturday, dad?

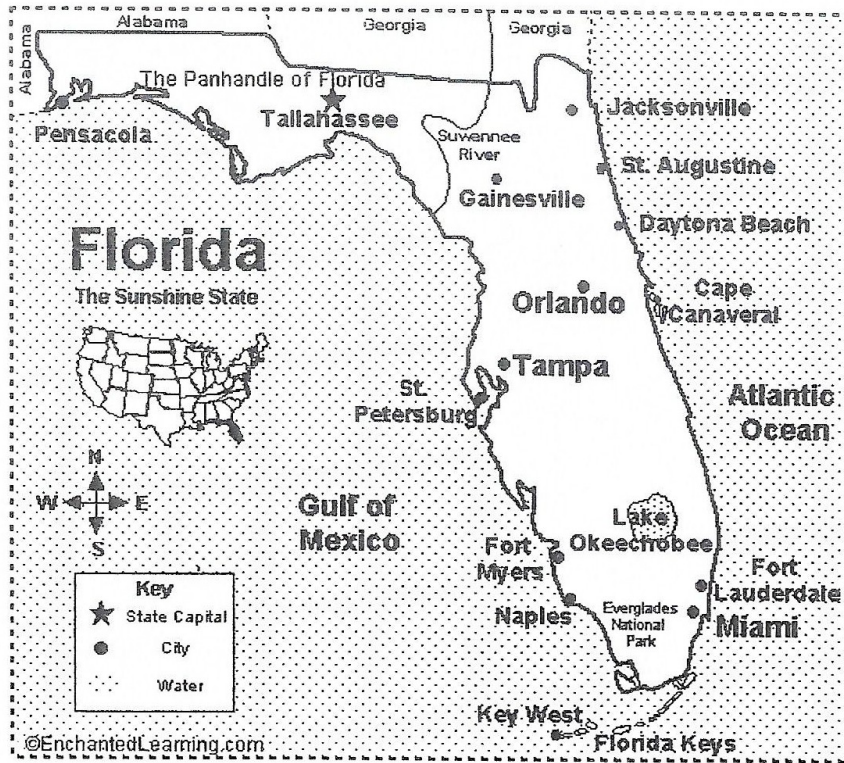
**Dad** Erm, no, I haven't. I've got a business meeting on Saturday.
