motorcycle

advantages	disadvantages
independent of parents at an early age	costs when you don't have a job: fuel...
nice to ride in nice weather	dangerous
friend can come with you when you are younger than 18	Bad for the environment, use bike instead
You can reach destinations quickly	You need special clothes – helmet..
Independent of bus schedule	

Car

advantages	disadvantages
independent of parents	costs for tax and insurance
independent of schedules	needs more fuel than motorcycle - costs

You can take friends	can be dangerous when driver has no experience
Safer than motorcycle	Often young people can only afford cheap old cars – bad for environment – exhaust fumes
