by-agent

The object of the active sentence becomes the subject of the passive sentence. The <u>by-agent</u> says who does it.


The "verb form" is always "be" + past participle. But of course the form of "be" changes according to the tenses (textbook p. 106).

3) Exercise passive

Here you can practise the passive in the different tenses.

Read the rules carefully. They tell you how the passive is formed. Then fill in the correct form of the verbs.

The past participle is the third form of the verb (1. show, 2. showed, 3. shown). In German it's called the *Partizip Perfekt*.
